

WILDLIFE SAFARI

Description:

In this event students will demonstrate their understanding of basic ecological concepts such as food chains, food webs, components of habitat and the impact of modern technology on our environment. They will also demonstrate their ability to identify various plants, insects, birds, mammals, etc. through the use of reference materials such as field guides.

Number of Participants: 2

Approximate Time: 50 minutes

The Competition:

Each team of two students will move from station to station. At each station they will be required to answer a basic ecology question, to identify a specimen using reference guides provided. Students will have two minutes at each station.

Scoring:

The scoring of the event will be based on the number of correct answers. One station will be timed and in the event of a tie, the fastest correct answer at that station will determine the breaking of the tie.
